Role:

The successful candidate will facilitate the 2SLGBTQ+ Community Connections Group. The role of the peer facilitator is to provide leadership and support to the 2SLGBTQ+ community in the Brantford, Brant area. This position is an opportunity to become more engaged in and support the 2SLGBTQ+ community in Brantford/Brant.

Responsibilities:

- Organize monthly peer social groups
- Ensure the group norms are adhered to at all times
- Keep the group engaged and manage conflict using a collaborative approach
- Attend volunteer orientation and role specific training
- Notify supervisor in advance if unable to be present for group
- Opportunity for other duties

Skills and Qualifications:

- Must be 18 years of age or older
- Member of the 2SLGBTQ+ community preferred
- ASIST, safeTALK and Mental Health First Aid training is an asset
- Have attended the 2SLGBTQ+ Community Connections (formerly LGBTQ+ Social) is an asset
- Facilitation experience an asset
- Training will be provided for peer facilitation and conflict management training
- Police check with vulnerable sector screening required

Time Commitment:

- 1 shift per month
- 1.5 hour shift
- Minimum 1-year term
