We are seeking a Community Worker as part of the Canada Summer Jobs program to join our collaborative team and provide support to clients and community members. The Community Worker will assist individuals in need of information about social assistance programs and services, community and social connections, and life skills support. The Community Worker will also promote programs and services to other agencies and the general public while maintaining knowledge of local resources and building strong, sustainable relationships with external agencies and partners. Hours of work– primarily days but to include some evening, weekend work as required.

Requirements:

- Be aged between 15 and 30 years old on the start date of the job
- Have a valid Social Insurance Number (SIN)
- Be a Canadian citizen, a permanent resident of Canada, or a person who has been granted refugee status in Canada
- Post-secondary education in a health or social science discipline
- Experience in health promotion and community development, including knowledge of vulnerable populations in Brantford and Brant County
- Experience in harm reduction, chronic disease management and injury prevention an asset
- Knowledge of and experience with group facilitation and co-facilitation
- Excellent interpersonal, communication, organizational and decision-making skills required
